

Joint ARCSA/ASPE Rainwater Catchment Systems Standard Receives ANSI Approval

New American National Standard helps safely

implement a rainwater catchment system using precipitation from rooftops and other hard, impervious surfaces.

The American Society of Plumbing Engineers (ASPE) is pleased to announce that ARCSA/ASPE/ANSI 63-2013: Rainwater Catchment Systems was approved as an American National Standard by the American National Standards Institute (ANSI) on November 14, 2013. Jointly developed by ASPE and the American Rainwater Catchment Systems Association (ARCSA) and co-sponsored by the International Association of Plumbing and Mechanical Officials (IAPMO) and NSF International, ARCSA/ASPE/ANSI 63-2013 is designed to assist engineers, designers, plumbers, builders/developers, local government officials, and end users in safely implementing a rainwater catchment system using precipitation from rooftops and other hard, impervious surfaces.

AWRA Fellow Member Award Recipient



Dr. Tamim Younos, President of Cabell Brand Center, has been awarded by the American Water Resources Association (AWRA) as a recipient of the Fellow Member Award. The award was presented during the AWRA Annual Water Resources Conference in Portland, OR November 4-7, 2013. Dr. Younos joined the Cabell Brand Center as Executive Vice President in July 2010. He previously served as a faculty member at Virginia Tech for nearly 30 years and was the interim director of the Virginia Water

Resources Research Center from 2002 to 2006. His research and educational interests include watershed assessment and management, small-scale decentralized water infrastructure and rainwater harvesting, urban stormwater management, water-energy nexus and mitigation of climate change impacts on the local level.

Dr. Younos has been a principal investigator for more than 40 research/technical projects and has authored or co-authored more than 150 publications including two edited books: Advances in Water Monitoring Research (2003) and "Total Maximum Daily Load: Approaches and Challenges" (2005). Dr. Younos has served on the Board of Directors for the American Water Resources Association (2005-2007), the Board of Directors for the National Institutes for Water Resources (2202-2006), and the Board of Directors for Renewable Natural Resources Foundation (2003-2008). He is past president of the Universities Council on Water Resources. He currently serves on the Editorial Board, International Water Technology Journal. Dr. Younos has presented invited talks in China, Japan, Hungary, Poland, Spain, and

Turkey, and conducted water related research in Egypt, Mexico, and the Dominican Republic.

ARCSA Workshops ARCSA Accredited Professional (AP)

This two day AP-level workshop, with a one day hands on rainwater system installation workshop, is an in-depth rainwater-harvesting course required for those seeking ARCSA Accredited Professional (AP) status. This course provides attendees with knowledge for rainwater harvesting, both active and passive, design and installation for both outdoor and inhome rainwater use both potable and non-potable; and larger commercial systems, touching on stormwater remediation sanitation for potable uses; rules and regulations, guidelines and restrictions; business management; project planning; site and installation safety; and system construction and maintenance.

The course will follow the Texas A&M University Rainwater Harvesting manual, which is included in the course tuition. Lunch and beverages are provided - There will be a free hands on installation on Sunday.

Sunday installation is not required for ARCSA AP.
