

### **Baseball Legend Nolan Ryan will be Keynote Speaker at Irrigation Association Conference**

Baseball hall of famer Nolan Ryan and Austin's hometown hero will deliver the keynote address and host a question-and-answer period during the General Session at the upcoming Irrigation Show and Education Conference, Nov. 4 - 8, in Austin, Texas.

With an unparalleled 27-season career (1966 - 1993) and several notable Major League records to his name, Nolan Ryan is no stranger to hard work and dedication - he boasts seven career no-hitters, 5,714 strikeouts and 12 one-hitters. After hanging up his glove in 1993, Ryan went on to own two minor league baseball teams and is now CEO of the Texas Rangers, where his influence on baseball operations has helped lead to three consecutive postseason appearances.

In his keynote address, Ryan will discuss how to take care of the customer. Ryan's strong commitment to customer satisfaction has played a key role in the success of his many business ventures. Since his arrival to the Rangers in 2010, the franchise has recommitted itself to enhancing the fan experience, establishing single season home

attendance records in each of the last two years and surpassing the 3million attendance mark for the first time in franchise history in 2012.

"I am incredibly excited to have Nolan Ryan as our keynote for the General Session in Austin, Texas," said Irrigation Association President Bob Dobson, CIC, CID, of Middletown Sprinkler Company. "Nolan Ryan is a nationally known personality and businessman who has a special connection with the folks in Texas. We are pleased to be able to have such a legend on our stage."

Chuck Morgan, public address announcer and senior vice president of ballpark entertainment for the Texas Rangers Baseball Club, will share the stage to moderate the Q&A portion of the address. Morgan has worked in professional baseball for over 30 years and was named the best public address announcer in Major League Baseball by The Sporting News in 2001 and 2003.

Open to all registered attendees, the General Session will take place Thursday, Nov. 7, 8:45 a.m. - 10:45 a.m. Doors open at 8:00 a.m. for a kick-off continental breakfast.

### **PLUMBING DESIGN STANDARD UPDATES**

ARCSA is awaiting the ASPE Board to give final approval of the Rainwater Harvesting Design Standard 63, a joint project between ASPE and ARCSA. We are expecting approval in the next few weeks.

The companion document, the ASPE-ARCSA Stormwater Harvesting Design Standard 78, is now in draft form and is being reviewed by a committee of experts. Once its review is completed, the Standard will go to the ASPE Board for final review and approval. Keep a look out for this new plumbing document in early 2014.

ARCSA is very excited about these two new plumbing standards in pursuit of harvesting rain for direct indoor and outdoor, non-potable and potable applications, such as low-volume irrigation and indoor flushing. In addition to direct applications of rain/stormwater, many passive, indirect applications of this water resource are already available in existing guidelines and manuals of the Low Impact Development, or Green Infrastructure types, e.g. earth projects such as infiltration pits, gravel trenches, rain gardens, biofilters and swales. A search on the Internet will guide you to dozens of examples. Many cities and states of North America have already published numerous design documents. These strategies also help in reducing flooding, CSOs; improving water quality; infiltrating water into the ground; evapotranspiration.

### ARCSA Workshop ARCSA Accredited Professional (AP) Workshop



ARCSA's "Accredited Professional" Workshop is a two-day, in-depth rainwater harvesting course required for those seeking ARCSA Accredited Professional (AP) status.

This course provides attendees with knowledge for rainwater harvesting design and installation for both outdoor and in-home rainwater use; sanitation for potable uses; rules and regulations, guidelines and restrictions; business management; project planning; site and installation safety; and system construction and maintenance.

This workshop fulfills the requirement for non-LEED specific CEUs in the Water Management category of the LEED Credential Maintenance Program. It may also count toward the categories of: Project Site Factors; Project Systems and Energy Impacts; as well as Acquisition, Installation and Management of Project Materials.

The course will follow the Texas AgriLife Extension "Rainwater Harvesting Planning" manual, which is included in the cost.
